View your speaker notes privately, while delivering a presentation on multiple monitors.

Using Presenter View is a great way to view your presentation with speaker notes on one computer (your laptop, for example) while your audience views the notes free presentation on a different monitor(Projected on a large screen, for example) PowerPoint only supports the use of two monitors for a presentation. However, you can configure to run a presentation on three or more monitors that are connected to one computer.
